

5 CHARITIES that will PICK UP FURNITURE FOR FREE

Donating furniture can simplify the moving process, especially if you can find an organization to pick up your items. This can be a real timesaver if you're moving quickly, and your unwanted furniture can benefit a struggling family. Look up the charities listed below that are in your area to see which stores accept furniture donations, what they'll accept, and how to arrange pickup. Policies may vary from store to store.

Habitat for Humanity

Habitat for Humanity runs Habitat ReStore, a thrift store selling secondhand furniture, appliances, home goods, and more. You can drop off items or schedule a pickup. The organization accepts most items, including coffee tables, sofas, tables, chairs, dressers, bookcases, and bed frames.

Goodwill

Most Goodwill stores offer free donation pickup services, especially for larger items.

Salvation Army

The Salvation Army often accepts large appliances as well as furniture.

AMVETS (American Veterans)

AMVETS is a veteran organization providing direct support to former service members, like helping veterans file claims with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and offering scholarships to veterans attending college. AMVETS accepts a limited amount of furniture, but it will pick up flat-screen TVs, computers, and exercise equipment.

The Arc

The Arc is an organization that supports adults and children with developmental disabilities, offering programs and services and advocating on their behalf. The organization has a pickup service and will come to collect donated clothing and household items. Often, the organization will resell these items to other distributors.
