

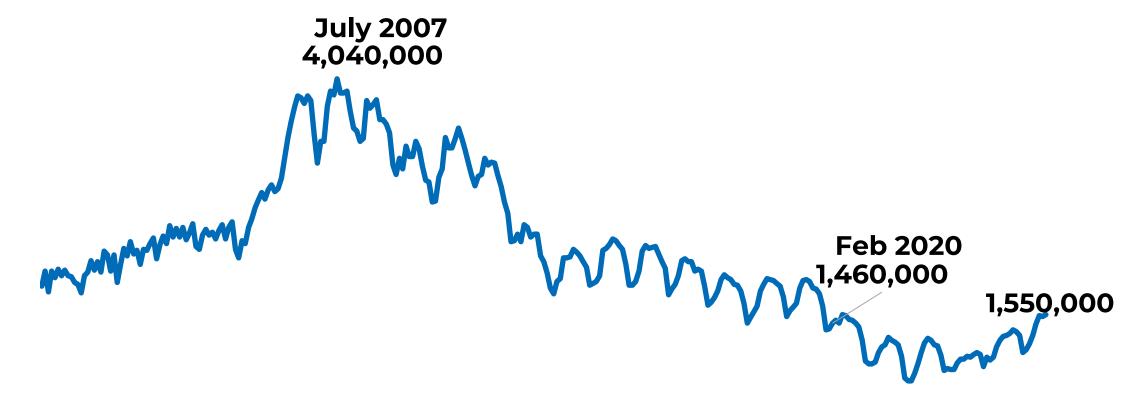

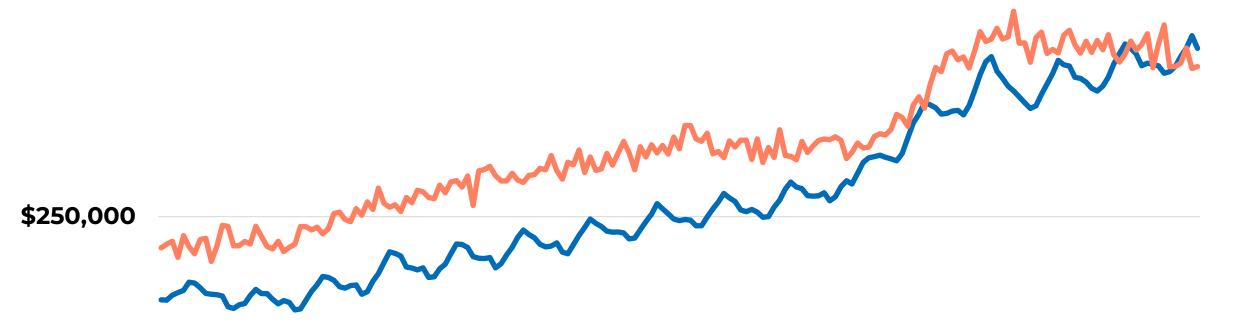

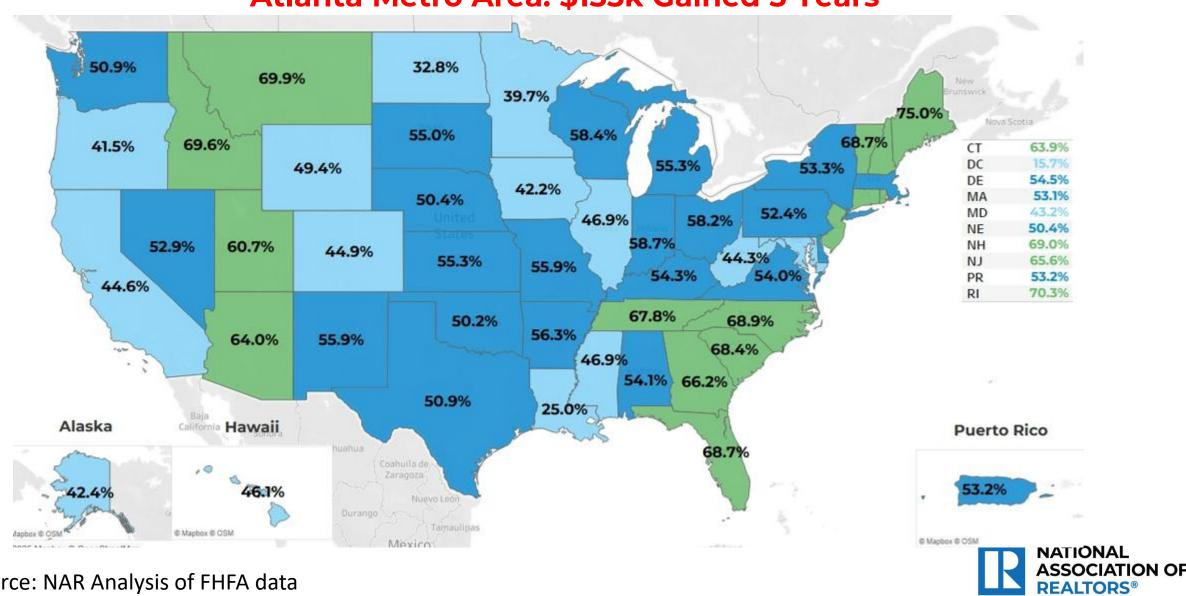

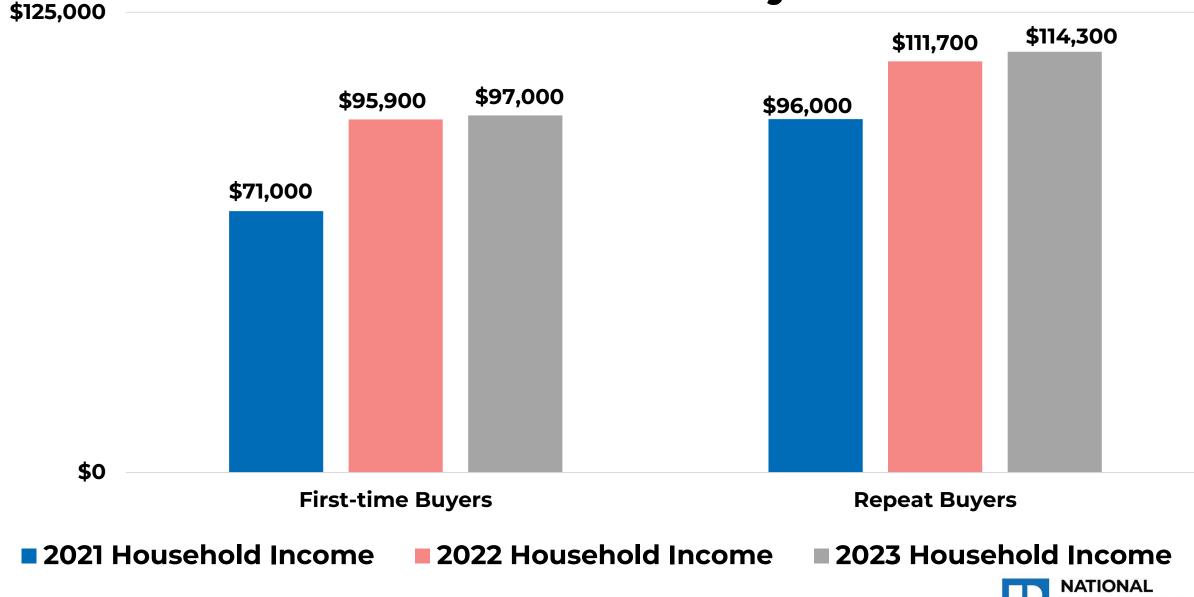

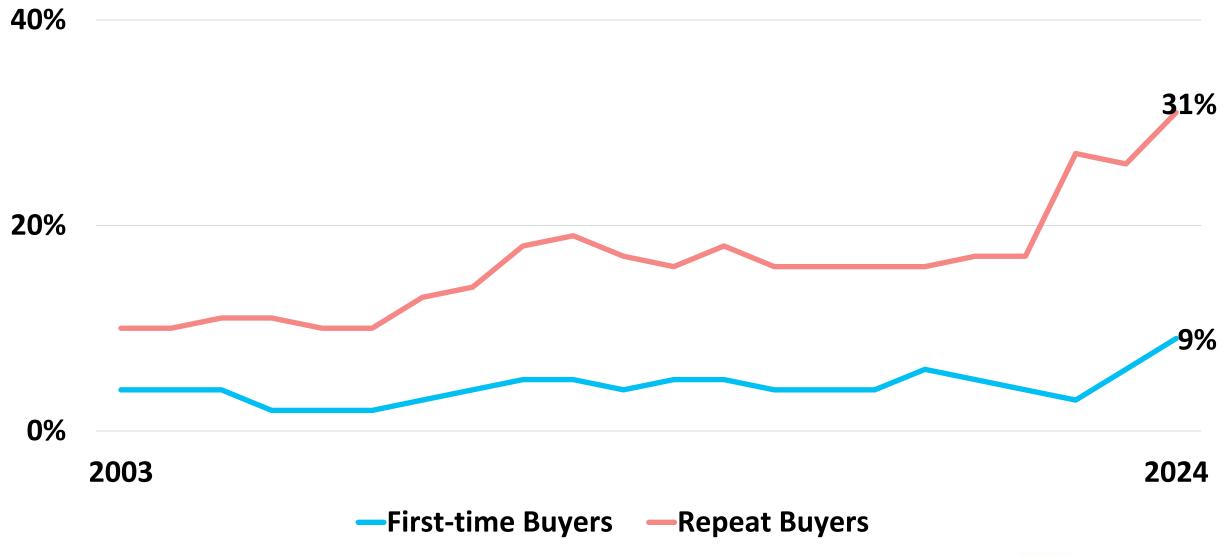

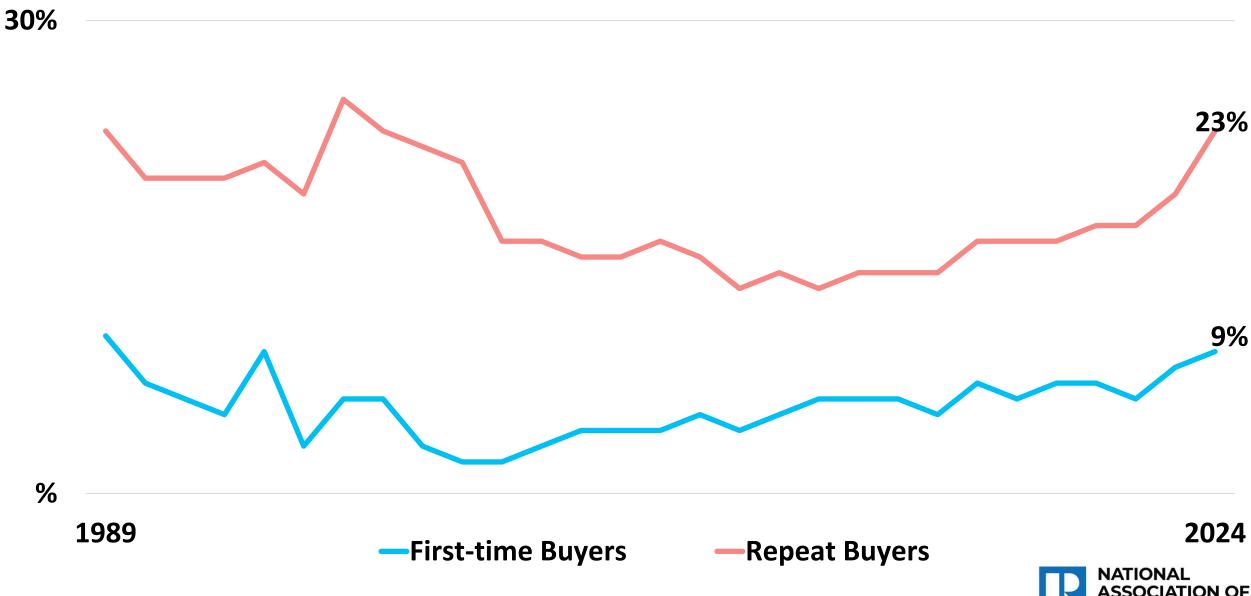


### All Cash Buyers Hit All-time High





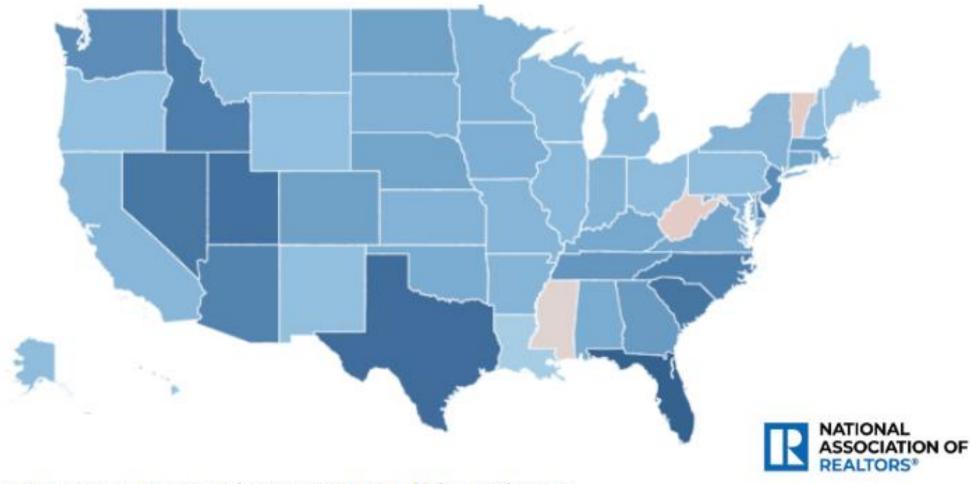
### **Downpayments Trend Higher**

**GA State Gained 116k and 1.1% Population** 



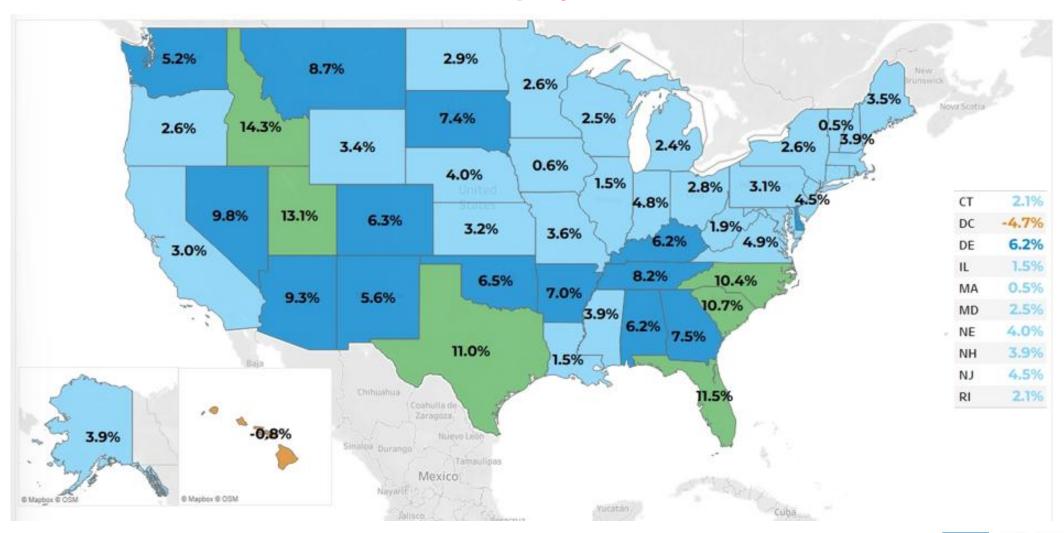

(% change from March 2020 to June 2025)

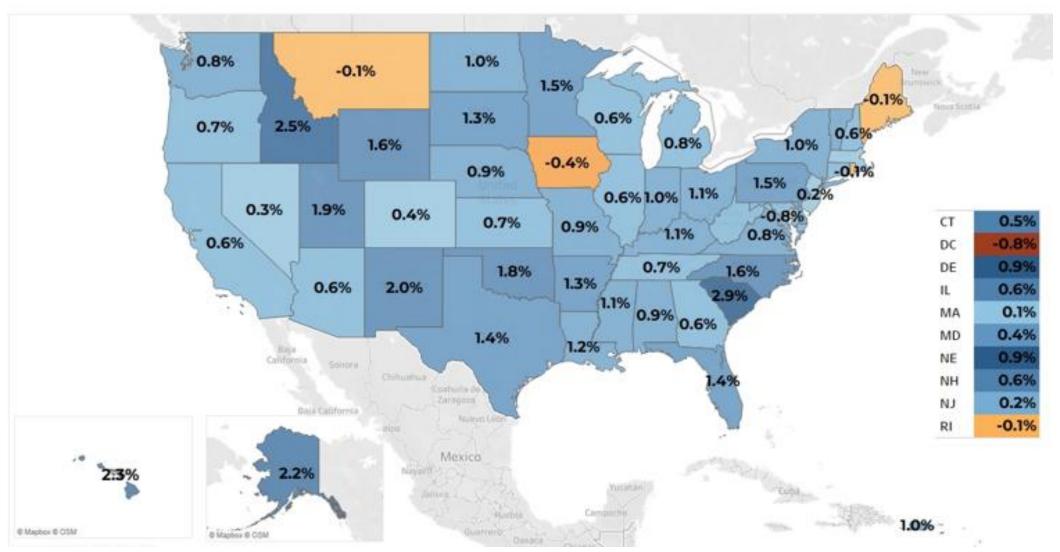

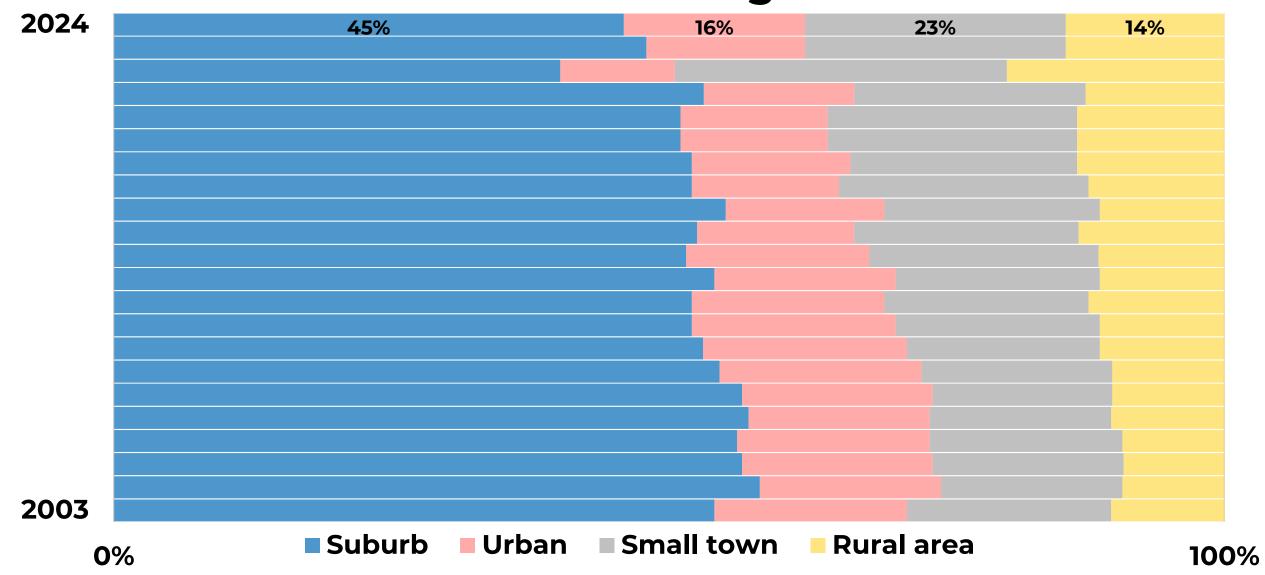
## Job Gains Over One Year - to Assess Recent Momentum (% change from June 2024 to June 2025)

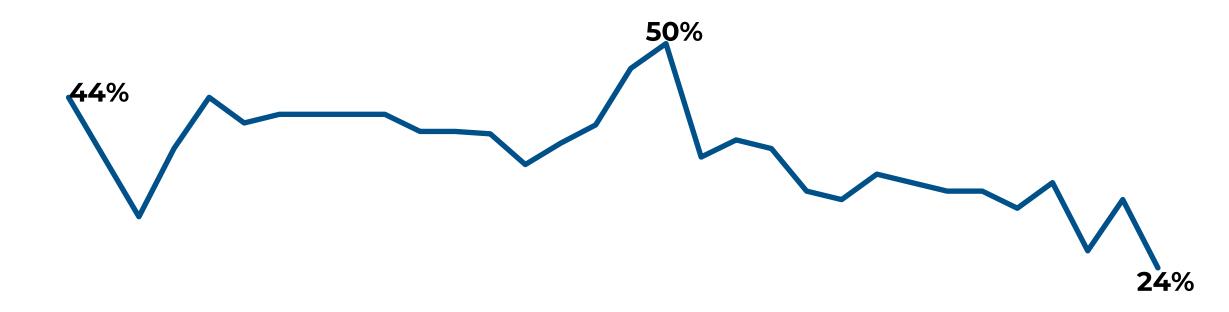
# Suburbs & Small Towns Most Popular, but Urban Areas Hit 10 Year High

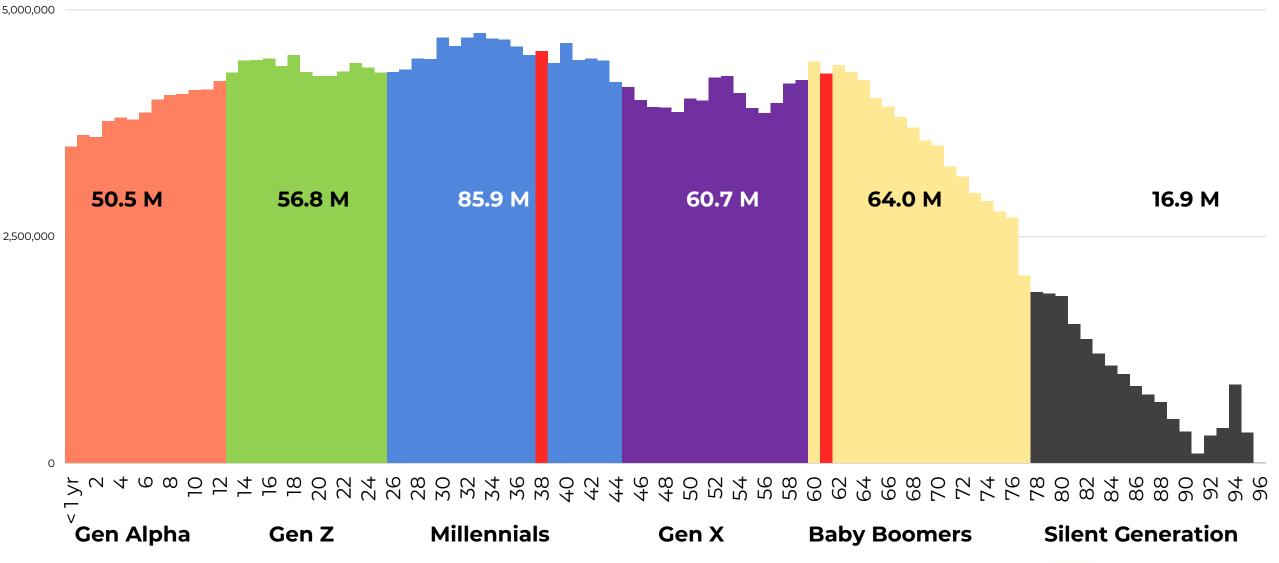

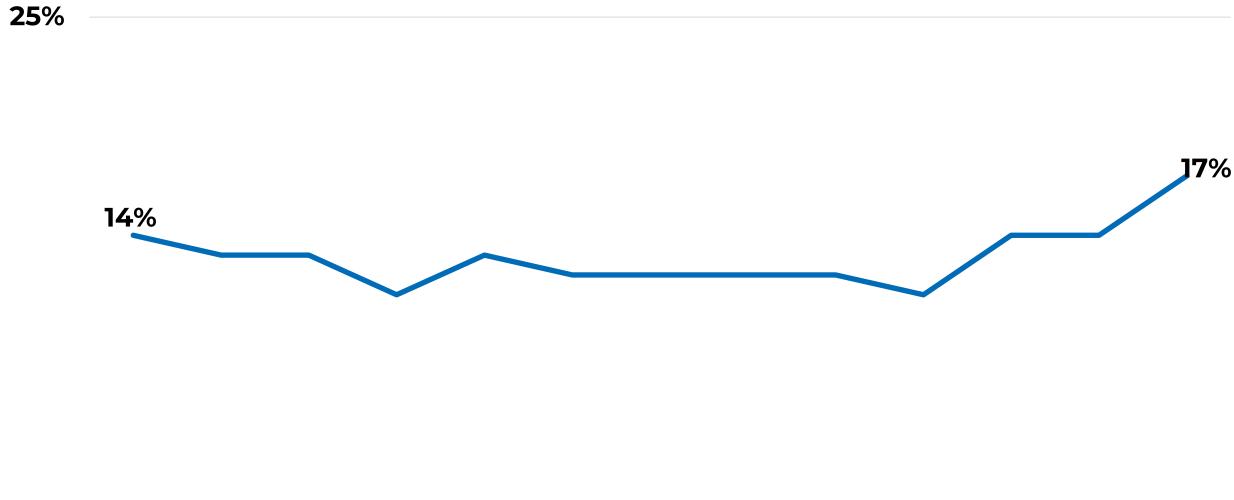


### U.S. Population by Age (in 2023)

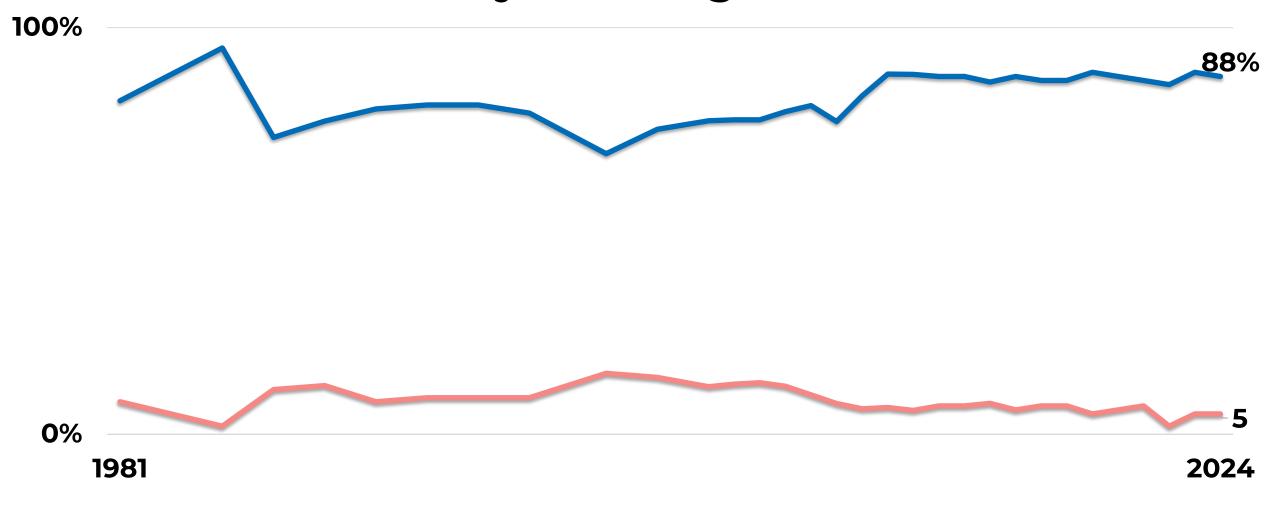

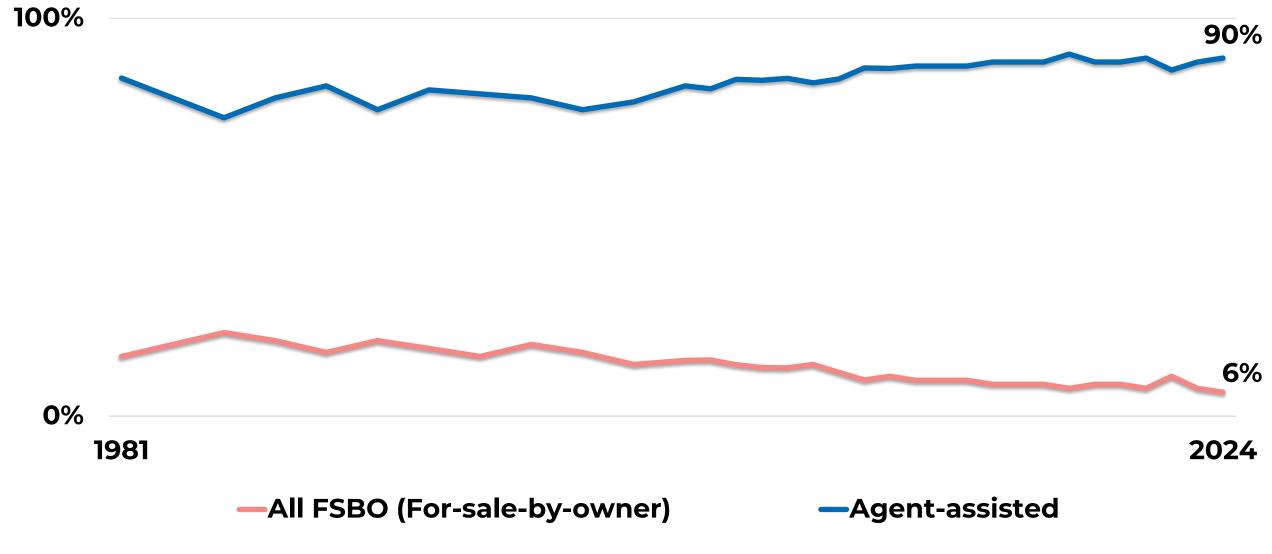

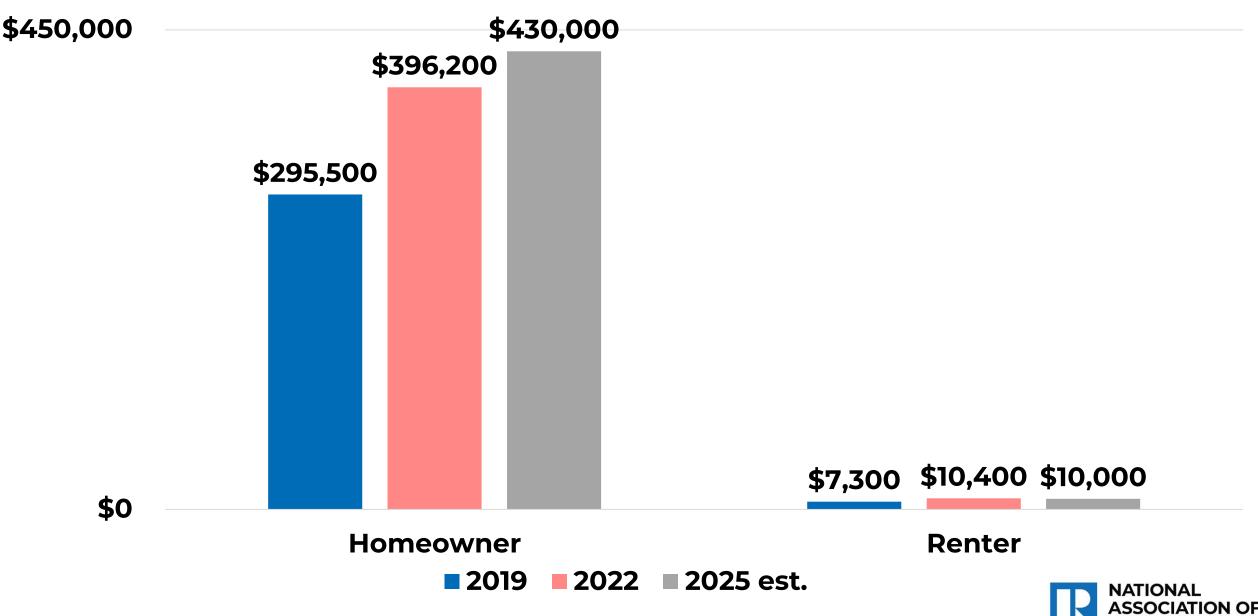
#### Seller's Agent Use High, FSBO All-Time Low

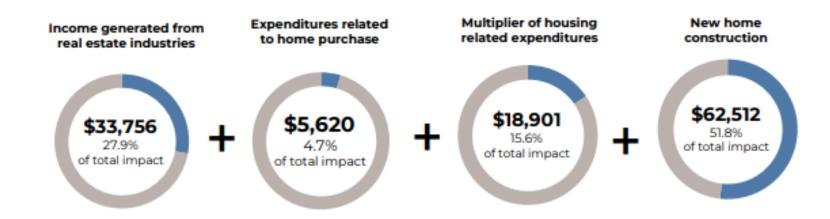

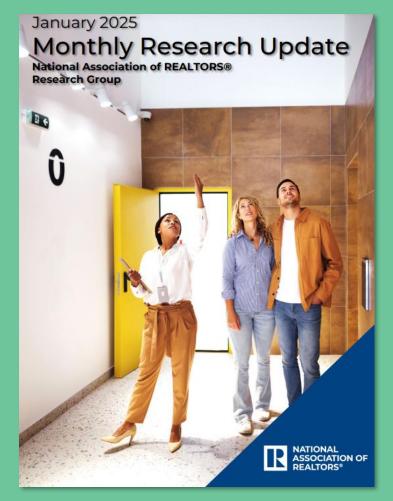

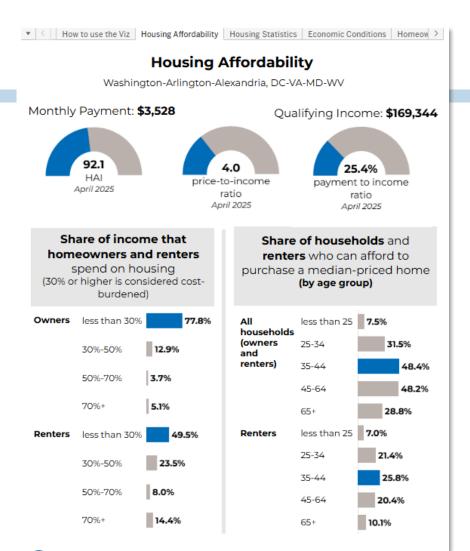
