ACTIVITY BASED ITEMS

To help make sure safety and infection prevention measures are in place, we ask that all donors follow the below guidelines:

- All toys must be brand new and unwrapped, with tags attached if applicable. We are unable to accept used items, or items purchased more than 3 months prior.
- Handmade items like blankets and scarves must be washed in an allergen-free detergent, before delivery and come from a smoke-free environment.
- Toys must be non-toxic.
- Toys promoting violence are not appropriate.
- Toys must be sturdy. Avoid toys that can break and leave sharp edges.
- Toys with numerous small parts that require close supervision are not appropriate.
- Fire regulations prohibit electrical, spark-producing, or friction-producing toys.
- DVDs must be rated G, PG or PG-13. We are unable to accept movies rated R or video games rated M.
- No latex
- No oversized stuffed animals
- No glitter in any form — glitter glue, glitter paper, etc.
- No religious or politically affiliated items
- No items promoting violence or death related insignias (skull and crossbones)
